

The Water I Shall Give Will Become A Spring Of Living Water Welling Up To Eternal Life

Mother Teresa - now canonised by the Church as St Teresa of Calcutta - felt that our greatest suffering is not our need or weakness itself, but the feeling of uselessness, of being worthless, unappreciated and unloved. She felt there is a voice in our culture that insist that only the beautiful and "successful" are loveable. She oved the story of Jesus and the Samaritan woman, feeling that the Samaritan woman symbolises our human poverty and yet the possibility of salvation. As a Samaritan the woman was an outcast and she was also a public sinner, losing her dignity as a person, and yet she had a life-changing encounter with Jesus.

In a letter to her Missionaries of Charity at Easter 1993, referring to the story of the Samaritan woman, Mother Teresa wrote:

"Jesus wants me to tell you again how much is the love he has for each one of you - beyond all you can imagine. Not only that he loves you; even more - he longs for you. He misses you even when you don't come close. He thirsts for you.

He loves you always, even when you don't feel worthy. Why does Jesus say, 'I thirst'? What does it mean? It is something so hard to explain in words. 'I thirst' is something much deeper than just Jesus saying, 'I love you'. Until you know deep inside that Jesus thirsts for you, you can't begin to know who he wants to be for you. Or who he wants you to be for him."


ST MATTHEW PASSION
