God's invitation to us is to celebrate with God in the Eucharist. It is in this celebration that we make present once again the mysterious act of salvation brought about by Christ's suffering, death and resurrection. The format in which we celebrate is a mixture of the synagogue service, welcoming God's Word among us, and the Last Supper at which Jesus anticipated, through the blessing and gift of the bread and wine, the sacrifice He was about to undergo. Why are so many reluctant to accept the invitation? The reasons given may be similar to the parables. We have other more pressing, more important things to do. There is also a failure in us to appreciate the full nature of the celebration, and we sometimes blame the celebrant or the form the liturgy takes for our drifting away. The liturgy is too traditional, too modern, too boring, too dull—and in our modern need for entertainment it can be all of these things. Any human attempt to express what is happening will fall short, though that does not take away the responsibility to try to catch something of the essence of God being among us as we gather in God's name.

ATTENDING PUBLIC MASS AT ST. BEDE'S CHURCH

When attending church for Mass or for prayer, we need to keep each other safe and observe the following guidelines:

- * Please WEAR YOUR OWN FACEMASK or face covering at all times except when receiving Holy Communion
- * Apply hand sanitizer when entering the church
- * Dispensation from the Sunday obligation remains and we actively encourage you to attend Mass any day of the week where possible
- * The number of parishioners able to attend each Mass will be limited to a maximum of 80
- * Toilets remain closed and the Cloister must be kept clear for access
- * Volunteers are needed to assist before and after each Mass, weekday and weekends (guidelines stipulate that volunteers must be below the age of 70 for this)
- * Please do not enter the Sacristy area via the side door in the Church as this is an emergency exit only
- ** Details will now be taken for everyone attending weekday Masses for Track and Trace purposes**

APP TO AID TRACK AND TRACE PROCESS

The government has launched a new system to aid the Track and Trace process and places of worship are on the list of venues. If you have the NHS App on your phone you can scan the QR Code on the way into the church in order to register your details with the Track and Trace programme. For anyone attending who is unable to use the NHS App, details will be logged as before and retained in line with government guidance.
