#### THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK

Today's beautiful second reading offers us the affirmation that we have been blessed with "all the spiritual blessings of heaven in Christ". It shows us the path from hesitation to affirmation, the path from uncertainty to freedom, and reassures us that we have been chosen in Christ to live "through love in His presence". This free gift of love from God, which finds its fullness in Christ's total self-giving love on the cross, is what will enable each one of us to be transformed, to leave our doubts and fears behind, to worry less about our qualifications and to be able to say "yes" to what seems impossible. While it is understandable that we may hesitate in the face of some of today's challenges, we can try not to let fear paralyse us and prevent us from achieving what we are called to, and capable of. The transformative antidote to such hesitation without doubt is love: Christ's love for us, and our love and support for one another. Like parents encouraging a hesitant child to walk, or affirming their child's first word, let us offer little transformative "moments" of love and affirmation to one another and to our world. In this we then, like the disciples, become apostles of healing to all those we encounter. And really the only qualification needed is an abundance and a sharing of love.
