**************** THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK

Our attachment to the things of life can be a bit like a scaly dragon skin. We build up around ourselves an ugly armour of sin - pride, fear, envy, anger that we hope will protect us from being hurt, but in truth only cuts us off from one another. Even the love of things that are good in themselves, whether it is food or work or money, or even friends and family, if that love is not properly ordered, can become something harmful and destructive. What does it mean for us to be "properly ordered"? It means loving more those things that are more worthy of love. The first of these, of course, is God, who is pure love, the fountain of love, a love that is stronger than death. So when Christ, in today's Gospel, claims that it is He who must be loved more than anything else, He is making a bold claim indeed: we must love Christ as God. Only by making Christ the focus of our lives will those lives be well ordered ... When we have dared to let in the warmth of divine love, we will need yet more courage, the courage to bear witness to our own transformation - even though as yet it has only just begun. Offering our testimony to Christ's love for all the world, whether aloud or in the silence of deeds, we will bring Christ's rewards to everyone we meet.

Closer to Christ Campaign Announcement Letter Holy Ghost and St Bede, Basingstoke

Dear Parishioners of Holy Ghost and St Bede,

I am sure you will agree when I say this last year has continued to be challenging. Yet although many aspects of our lives have been impacted, our Catholic faith has remained the one constant. I also wish to thank wholeheartedly those clergy who continue to work so tirelessly to sustain and support the communities under their care. It is this steadfast commitment that has progressed the Church across the Diocese of Portsmouth since the late 19th century.

As a faith community, we have been through some challenging times in the past yet by God's grace, we have always shown resilience, compassion and generosity. Over fifteen years ago, the *Living Our Faith* campaign had a tremendous and wide-reaching effect, and I am grateful for all it enabled. I am confident now with the intercession of the parish of Holy Ghost and St Bede and our patron, St. Edmund of Abingdon, that we have the strength to continue our great mission of 'Bringing people closer to Jesus Christ through His Church'.

Further to much prayer, consideration and consultation with clergy and laity, we have embarked on a new fundraising initiative entitled the *Closer to Christ* Campaign. This will build upon the mission of our church, enabling us to continue our journey to become ever more outward facing and evangelistic, while meeting the immediate financial priorities of parishes, who are the backbone of our Church.

Central to the success of our mission, is the continued support of our clergy at all stages of ministry, those individuals who give their lives to serve our parish communities. *Closer to Christ* will fund our seminarians and priests in active ministry and rejuvenate our parishes, ensuring they have the necessary resources to provide a place for prayer, worship and community interaction, meeting a broad range of faith needs and giving them a platform to thrive. We must also care for our priests in their retirement, recognising the important work they have achieved in delivering our mission and the contribution they continue to make in so many ways following a life of service and dedication to local parish life. At a time when the average weekly donation per parishioner is just over two pounds, we need everyone in every parish to help us by supporting our priests and our parishes.

The *Closer to Christ* Campaign is a 'call to action' which invites all parishioners to become more fully and sacrificially involved in the life of the Church – to collectively build God's Kingdom and live the Gospel, especially in providing for others. Simultaneously, the *Closer to Christ* Campaign reflects a commitment to enhanced communications and stewardship of donors' generosity. By the end of this year, every parish will have participated in this endeavour. Since the Campaign started, nearly 50 parishes have taken part and I am delighted that Holy Ghost and St Bede, Basingstoke will be part of the next group of parishes leading the way.

In the coming months, Father John will be sharing with you in more detail the objectives of this initiative – through individual conversations, small group gatherings and announcements at Mass. I appreciate your willingness to learn more, ask questions, consider the role you could play and importantly pray for our success.

Towards the end of his Letter to the Philippians, St. Paul says: "There is no need to worry, but if there is anything you need, pray for it, asking God for it with prayer and thanksgiving" (Phil 4: 6). I look forward to us all accomplishing together the Lord's work, moving from maintenance to mission.
