LITANY OF THE SACRED HEART

Bishop Philip writes 'This summer month of June is customarily dedicated to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. Indeed, last Friday, 16th June, was the Solemnity of the Sacred Heart and a Day of Prayer for Priests. Anyway, a most beautiful prayer you could say to the Sacred Heart is the Litany of the Sacred Heart. The Litany was approved for public use by Pope Leo XIII in 1899, although its origins go back to the late 17th century. It has 33 invocations of the Sacred Heart, one for each year of the public life of our Lord. In your daily prayer-time this month, why not take two or three of the invocations each day to reflect and meditate on, thus working your way through?'

FORTY MARTYRS OF ENGLAND AND WALES

Shalom World, the online Catholic TV station, will be broadcasting a new series of its 'Forty Martyrs of England and Wales' documentaries every Thursday at 9 pm from 22nd June. The first programmes last year were written by Dora Nash, a parishioner of Our Lady & St Edmund in Abingdon and author of the well-known First Communion book 'Jesus Comes to Me'.
