THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK

We might have all kinds of technologies and more advanced thinking to help grow crops nowadays, but human nature hasn't changed. The analogy Jesus offers between the seed and the condition in which it might thrive, or die, is just as valid now. God is the sower of the seed of faith, but it is down to us as to what happens next. We are the ground in which the seed will flourish or fail and it is up to us to see that our faith grows and develops. Of course there is help available if we seek it out, from our own prayers and those of others, as well as the support that the Church can give. But we have to be ready to focus on God and on caring for our faith. Becoming distracted by temptations of the world, whether it's drink, drugs, possessions, or just too much focus on our own pleasure, will not help us grow in faith. And being caught up in work, or our own anxieties - not trusting God - will also cause us to lose heart and become separated from God. Faith is not something that happens once and lasts for all time: it needs us to constantly be converted to God.
