In addition to this our Pastoral Area is now aligned with Andover and the Northeast Hampshire Pastoral Area to become once again Blessed John Body Deanery. One of Fr John's duties will be to promote and coordinate common pastoral action in the Deanery as directed by the Bishop and following the Mission Plan *You will be my Witnesses*. CALLED AND GIFTED PROGRAMME
