THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK

King Cyrus of Persia, spoken of by Isaiah in today's first reading, brought the Jews back to Israel. It was the role of Cyrus in restoring Israel that first showed the Jews that their God was the God of the whole world. Cyrus was the instrument of God, but he did not know that. We may not do the great things that Cyrus did, but the small things we do have more meaning that anything he did. That is because we know that our lives are shaped by God. Every encounter, every word we say, everything we do, is under God's providence. We are all instruments of God's purpose. This does not mean that we are free from sin, and it certainly does not mean that our sins do not matter. What it does mean is that if we see mercy, then our sin can add to the glory of God, by showing the limitless power of God's mercy. If we refuse then we become like Cyrus, unconscious instruments of God. We still serve God but unwillingly, and out of this can grow resentment and anger. Unlike the coin that Christ held in His hand, there is no limit to the value that we can have in God's eyes. The coin has a fixed value, but we are like a coin that God can use again and again.
