#### THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK

In today's Gospel reading, Jesus uses the marriage practices of His time and place to teach a more serious lesson. This time our reason for staying awake and on the watch is not merely about the weather, but about our future destiny in the Kingdom of God. We have been invited to the wedding feast of Christ to His bride, the Church. As members of the Church, we are all, as it were, bridesmaids waiting for the Lord to come and take us to His house. In many traditional rituals it is still an important event when the bridegroom takes his bride from her house to his. It requires some ceremony, perhaps a procession with torches. At our Baptism, we were presented with a burning candle which was entrusted to us to be kept burning brightly so that we will be ready to welcome our Lord when He comes. In the early Church there was an expectation that Christ would come again very soon to take His bride to Himself. As time went by, the expectation diminished and people grew tired with waiting. In some cases, the light was flickering and dying. People needed to be encouraged to stay awake, to be on the watch, to keep the flame of their faith alive.
