There are many examples in literature of people, who, through the course of the story, move from despair to hope, selfishness to generosity, darkness to light. CHRISM MASS

The Chrism Mass this year takes place on Tuesday 26th March 2024 at 11am in the Cathedral and Bishop Philip wishes to invite you to it!. The Mass is the special Liturgy in Holy Week during which the Bishop blesses the three Holy Oils for use in the Sacraments: the Oil of the Blessing of the Sick, the Oil of Catechumens and the Oil of Chrism. The blessing of the Holy Oils is one of the most ancient ceremonies of the Church and it is always celebrated in the Cathedral with the priests, deacons, religious and lay people of the diocese. The Mass is one of the main Diocesan events of the year and during it, all the priests make a renewal of their commitment to priestly service. It is always a wonderful manifestation of the Church in our Diocese of Portsmouth and an opportunity to thank God for our Catholic faith.
