Peter denies he even knows Him. The crowd which cheered and waved palms when He entered Jerusalem now turns nasty when they find He's not going to drive the Romans out. Shouts of "Hosanna" become

Jesus accepts all this suffering for our sake. As we heard in the reading from the letter to the Hebrews, "He became, for all who obey Him, the source of eternal salvation". We can't be physically with Jesus as we remember and re-enact the events of so long ago during Holy Week, but by opening our hearts as we proceed from Passion Sunday, through Holy Thursday and Goo Friday, we can share in the joy of the risen Lord on Easter Day.
