THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK

Jesus is very fond of the image of the vine. He also uses other pastoral images: the flowers of the field, ears of corn and seed that is sown, but He likens the Kingdom of Heaven to a vineyard on more than one occasion. In today's reading He speaks of Himself as the vine of which we are the branches. He then uses images from the practices of cultivating a vine to deepen our understanding of how we may become His disciples. The images He uses apply equally to vine cultivation today as in the time of Jesus. Jesus says we are pruned by His words. It is through listening to Him that we stay on the right course and produce fruit.
