THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK

At first sight, Jesus' words in today's Gospel seem to be harsh. Is He recommending that a worker who's tired out by a day's ploughing in the fields should then have to wait hand and foot on his master, who's been sitting around doing nothing all day? It seems quite out of character of the compassionate and caring Jesus. But it has a different ring if we note that Jesus begins His story by saying in effect to His disciples "Which one of you wouldn't behave like this?" Is He belittling them? Rather, we could rather say He is warning them. He has chosen them but they still need to learn. We remember other accounts in the Gospels where the disciples are arguing among themselves about who is greatest in the kingdom. Or when Jesus shows them a little child and tells them to stop being silly. Or the time when the mother of James and John comes to Jesus asking for top-management jobs for her two boys. In today's reading, Jesus reminds them, that as servants, they are only doing what they are meant to do. In other words, they are not to become proud or puffed up. All they have and can do depends on God's kindly grace that is given them.

The Rosary for Peace will be held during the Jubilee of Marian Spirituality, which takes place on October 11-12. That day also marks the 63rd anniversary of the opening of the Second Vatican Council, which Pope St. John XXIII opened on October 11, 1962.
