In our first reading the prophet Ezekiel has a vision of the water of life flowing from the Temple. It echoes the words Jesus himself spoke in the Temple in Jerusalem "If anyone thirsts, let him come to me and drink." We heard St Paul, exasperated by the factions of the Christians in Corinth, telling them they had drifted from Jesus who was the foundation they were to build on. In the Gospel, John shows us an angry Jesus who is appalled by the blasphemy of God's holy Temple becoming a marketplace and a corrupt one at that. The Lateran Basilica is adorned with beautiful mosaics depicting Our Lady, Saints Peter and Paul, John the Evangelist, John the Baptist and smaller figures of St Francis and Anthony of Padua – but today, Remembrance Sunday, we pray to and for people who might be uncanonised saints, whose good works are known only to God and to those for whom they literally laid down their lives. God has remained alongside and within His suffering people and those who have fought for peace. With God's help, we can live, we can rebuild, we can look to the future.

FEAST OF THE LATERAN BASILICA

This Sunday is the Feast of the Dedication of the Lateran Basilica, the oldest and most important of the four major basilicas in Rome. The Basilica of St. John Lateran is the Cathedral of the Diocese of Rome, and is the official seat of the Holy Father as the Bishop of Rome (not St. Peter's Basilica as many mistakenly think). In ancient times, this was the church in the city where everyone was baptised. It is the oldest church in the Western world, built in the time of Constantine and consecrated by Pope Sylvester in 324. It became a feast kept throughout the Church as a sign of love for and union with the See of Peter, and a day to pray for the Pope's intentions.

REMEMBRANCE SUNDAY

Bishop Philip writes 'This Sunday is also Remembrance Sunday when we commemorate the contribution of British and Commonwealth military and civilian servicemen and women in the two World Wars and since. The Day is kept on the second Sunday in November, the Sunday nearest to 11th November, Armistice Day, the end of hostilities in the First World War in 1918. It is usually kept by two minutes' silence at 11am. Across the land, there will be numerous ceremonies at local war memorials in most cities, towns and villages, attended by civic dignitaries, ex-servicemen and women, members of the Royal British Legion and other veterans' organisations, and members of local armed forces regular and reserve units, military cadet forces and youth organisations such as the Boys and Girls Brigades, Scouts and Guides. Here in Portsmouth, where this day is naturally a big day given the links with the Royal Navy and the war efforts over the decades, wreaths will be laid at the memorial by the Guildhall. Representatives of the Judiciary also lay wreaths at local War Memorials throughout the country. Wreaths of remembrance poppies are laid on the memorials. The reason poppies are used to remember those who have given their lives in battle is because in the midst of the filth and mud in the fields of Flanders, they were the flowers which despite it all grew on the battlefields. At the going down of the sun, and in the morning, we will remember them!

During November, the Holy Father asks us to pray for the prevention of suicide. Let us pray that those who are struggling with suicidal thoughts might find the support, care, and love they need in their community, and be open to the beauty of life.
