THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK

In today's reading Jesus teaches that His followers are to be salt and light to the world. The first reading, from Isaiah, also speaks about how, when you bring food to those who are hungry, "Then shall your light break forth like the dawn". This teaching is about bringing hope and compassion to the world through our actions. Not so that we will receive praise, honour or glory, but so that others may come to know the love of God. As St Francis of Sales said, "Do not speak of God to those who don't ask. But live so that, sooner or later, they will ask." The late Pope Francis, in a homily, said that the purpose of the salt is "to give flavour to the lives of others," not to keep for oneself. He also asked the question, "What must a Christian do in order for the salt not to run out?" He explained that prayer is what lights up Christian life. "You can do many works of charity... but if you do not pray, it will be dark and dimly lit. The way that the salt is tasted, and the light seen, is through our contributions to the community. In essence, we commit all our efforts to make the world a better place. Through our love for others, especially for all those who are hated and excluded, we turn to God in prayer, asking for the courage to face difficulties and to stand alongside all those who are in pain.
